

Descendants of John Francis DeLong, Jr.

Generation No. 1

1. DR. JOHN FRANCIS⁴ DELONG, JR. (*JOHN FRANCIS³, GEORGE², (JAMES? OR FRANCIS?)¹*) was born 27 Apr 1802 in Ohio or Pennsylvania, and died 07 Sep 1873 in Noble Co., OH. He married (1) ELIZABETH JONES 20 Aug 1826 in Guernsey Co., OH. She was born 06 Sep 1802 in Noble Co., OH - on Jones farm, near cemetery where she is buried, and died 27 Mar 1844 in Noble Co., OH. He married (2) JULIANA/JULIA ANN TURNER 21 Jan 1845 in Belmont Co., OH or Guernsey Co., OH. She was born 01 Oct 1818 in Pennsylvania or Maryland, and died May 1901.

Notes for DR. JOHN FRANCIS DELONG, JR.:

Most sources refer to this man as "Doctor" John F. DeLong. He was a physician.

One source states that John was born Apr. 27, 1802 in Baltimore, MD. or Pennsylvania. John Baldwin, a DeLong researcher, states he has found nothing to support the claim that John was born in or around Baltimore, MD. None of K. Feisel's research has revealed anything to even hint that John Francis DeLong, Jr. ever was in Baltimore, MD. Death records in Noble Co. for Beaver Twp., Ohio state he died Sept. 7, 1873 at the age of 72 years 4 months 8 days, which would make his birth date Apr. 30, 1801. He died of whooping cough fever and was a farmer. His birth place is given as Jefferson County (presumably Ohio?). His grave marker states he died at 72 years of age.

The book "Gateway to the West" by Ruth Bowers and Anita Short - Volume 1 - pg. 545 shows a list of land acquisitions in Guernsey County. In that list is a John DeLong who purchased property in 1826 in Section 3, Township 8, Range 7. It indicates the complete record can be found in Volume J, pg. 506, at the county Recorder's office. (THIS WAS MOST LIKELY LAND PURCHASED BY THIS JOHN'S FATHER - JOHN FRANCIS DELONG, SR. since later land purchases by John Jr. are actually listed as "John DeLong, Jr.")

"Gateway to the West" - Volume 1, pg. 547, also shows John DeLong, Jr. acquiring the following pieces of property in Guernsey County. In 1831, land in Section 7, Township 8, Range 7 (Volume J, pg. 507); Karen has verified this deed index entry and also has on file a copy of the actual land patent from the U. S. government dated June 1, 1831, which states it was 80.32 acres in the West half of the Northwest quarter of Section 7, and indicates that when John made the purchase his residence was in Guernsey Co., OH; today that property is in Beaver Twp., Noble Co., OH. In 1833, land in Section 13, Township 8, Range 7 (Volume J, pg. 508); Karen has verified this deed index entry and also has on file a copy of the actual land patent from the U. S. government which was issued to John DeLong, Jr. AND Thomas DeLong (most likely his brother Thomas) on April 16, 1833 for 79.4 acres in the above location, specifically the East half of the Northeast quarter of Section 13, and that both John and Thomas were residing in Guernsey Co. when they made the purchase; today that property would be in Beaver Twp., Noble Co., OH. Also noted by Karen in deed book Vol. J, pg. 501 is a deed dated 1836 wherein Thomas DeLong and his wife sold 40 acres of land located in Range 7, Twp. 8, Section 13 to John DeLong, Jr. for \$100.

Additional land records found by Karen Feisel reveal the following.

- A land patent dated June 16, 1826 from the U. S. government to John DeLong, Jr., whose residence at the time of purchase (date unknown) was Guernsey Co., OH, for 79.92 acres of land in Range 7, Twp. 8, the West half of the Southwest quarter of Section 8, which today would be in Beaver Twp., Noble Co.
- Record in Guernsey Co. deed index book Vol. H, pg. 196, shows that in 1832 Jared Jones and his wife Nancy Agnes DeLong (sister to John) sold to John DeLong 4-1/4 acres of land in Range 7, Twp. 8, Section 8, for the sum of \$17 (this land would now be in Beaver Twp., Noble Co., OH).
- A deed dated 1836 in the Guernsey Co. index book, Vol. J, pg. 499, wherein Thomas DeLong and wife sold to John DeLong, Jr. 40 acres of land in Range 7, Twp. 8, Section 7 (now in Beaver Twp., Noble Co., OH) for \$100.

The 1850 census for Beaver Twp., Noble Co., OH, family #959, shows the following: John DeLong, age 49, farmer, real estate value \$700, born OH; Julia A. DeLong, age 32, born PA; William, age 13, born OH; Thomas, age

9, born OH; Ocans (?sp -- probably Owen), age 5, born OH; Charles, age 3, born OH; and Julia, age 1, born OH.

The 1860 census for Beaver Twp., Noble Co., OH, on page 512, shows the following: John DeLong (age 59-farmer); Julia (age 40-domestic); Thomas (age 20-farm hand); Owen D. (age 14); Charles (age 12); Julie A. (age 11); Sevilla A. (age 8); Richard (age 9); Milissia (age 6); James (age 2); Francis (age 2)-This would be James' twin Isadore FRANCIS. The postal address is Williamsburg. All are listed as being born in Ohio except John's wife Julia who was born in Pennsylvania.

Additional information regarding John and Juliana's children came from Susan Couch who has a database in Ancestry.com and from the book titled "Bernard Wintringer and His Descendants."

Pearl Gallagher Reischman of Barnesville, OH states that John DeLong, Jr. was a physician, which is also stated in the Wintringer book previously cited.

Notes for ELIZABETH JONES:

Elizabeth's tombstone reads, "Elizabeth Delong, consort of John Delong, who departed this life March 27, 1844, aged 37 years." This would mean that she was born around 1807, not 1802.

Juliana was the daughter of Richard Plummer Turner and Mary Wells. Family researcher Terry Terrell states that Juliana was living in Noble Co., OH in 1880.

Belmont Co. Marriages, Book 7, 1844-1849, Vol. IX, page 59, states John Delong and Julia Ann Turner were married on Jan. 21, 1845 by Philip Feley. Another source states the marriage took place on Jan. 17, 1845 in Belmont Co., OH.

Notes for WILLIAM DELONG:

William served in Company K, 78th Regiment, of the Ohio Volunteer Infantry during the Civil War. He died of

disease in Mississippi. However, the records of researcher Barbara Dailey's grandmother state that William died July 26, 1862 at war in Tennessee. Barbara states that she spoke with a man at Shiloh Battlefield, and they have a record of William and his brother Tom having fought at Shiloh; the battle was in April of 1862 so they could have died of wounds suffered in the battle. There is no record of them being buried there, and her contact didn't think they would have been buried "unidentified". She is searching further for burial info.

Notes for THOMAS DELONG:

The 1860 census shows Thomas as a female farm-hand, but the 1850 census shows him as male. Thomas served in the Civil War in Company K, 78th Regiment of the Ohio Volunteer Infantry. He died in Tennessee from disease.

Family researcher Barbara Dailey states that she spoke with a man at Shiloh Battlefield, and they have a record of Tom and his brother William having fought at Shiloh; the battle was in April of 1862 so they could have died of wounds suffered in the battle. There is no record of them being buried there, and her contact didn't think they would have been buried "unidentified." She is searching further for burial info.

Notes for OWEN DEANER DELONG:

Owen served in Company D, 60th Regiment of the Ohio Volunteer Infantry during the Civil War, receiving a shoulder wound. Barbara Dailey reported to Karen Feisel that she found in the April 01, 1880 issue of the "Cambridge Jeffersonian" a report that Owen Delong, a farmer near Batesville, committed suicide by hanging on Friday, March 27, 1880.

Notes for CHARLES AGUSTUS DELONG:

It is highly possible that Charles was in the military during the Civil War. The publication "History of Noble County, Ohio, with Portraits and Biographical Sketches of some of its Pioneers and Prominent Men" pub. by L. H. Watkins & Co., shows on pg. 269 a listing of "Noble County in the War". One of the privates listed is a Charles DeLong, age 18, enlisted Sept. 16, 1864. Although Charles wouldn't have been 18 until 1965, it's possible he lied a little about his age in order to be accepted into the military.

Family researcher Barbara Dailey states Charles' middle name was "Agustus."

Julia never married according to records of researcher Terry Terrell.

Notes for CECILIA/OCELIA/SEVILLA/SELINA DELONG:

The 1860 census for Beaver Twp., Noble Co., OH, page 512, shows the John DeLong family and one of the children is a "Sevilla A." age 8. There is no "Cecelia" listed, but all other children appear.

"Cecilia" never married and died at age 72. She is buried beside her sister Melissa Ann and her dates are shown as 1852-1926, along with the words "Daus. of JOHN DELONG."

Notes for MELISSA ANN "ANNA" DELONG:

Melissa is buried beside her sister Cecelia DeLong. The tombstone shows her dates to be 1854-1926, her name as Melissa Ann Bain, and includes the words "daus. of JOHN DELONG." Since Melissa is buried beside Melissa it could be that her husband predeceased her.

Jerome does not appear in the 1860 or 1870 census listing for his alleged parents' household in Beaver Twp., Noble Co., OH which means that perhaps he was born after 1860, or that maybe this Jerome DeLong belongs to

some other family.

Notes for MRS. MARY ELIZABETH (BOYD) JEFFRIES:

Mary was the daughter of Thomas Boyd and Susannah Ramsey. She was first married to John Andrew Jefferies. He died at age 24, leaving Elizabeth with two infant sons, Joseph and Clarence.

Notes for JAMES SEBASTIAN DELONG:

James was a twin to his brother Isadore Francis ("Frank") DeLong. James was a farmer. Was reported in the 1920 census for Beaver Twp., Noble Co., OH.

KF has on file a copy of James' death certificate. He was the husband of Elizabeth Watson and died on Mar. 11, 1932 in Wheeling city, Ohio County, West Virginia - in the "O.V.G. Hospital" at age 73y 5m 11d, birth date shown as Sept. 30, 1858. James' residence is shown as Quaker City, OH. His occupation shown as farmer, b. Ohio, son of John DeLong who was born in France, and Julia Turner who was born in PA. Informant signature by George DeLong of Wheeling, WV. Cause of death croupous pneumonia. Buried at Quaker City, OH on Mar. 12, 1932. (A look at county maps reveals that Quaker City is in Millwood Twp., Guernsey County, OH - just over the county line from Beaver Twp., Noble Co., OH.) The Informant signature by George DeLong would have been James' son George who appears in the 1930 census in Wheeling, WV, age 45, born OH.

Notes for SARAH CATHERINE "KATE" SHERMAN/SHUMAN:

K. Feisel has on file a photo of a grave marker for "Sarah, Consort of James DeLong" from the St. Mary's/Beaver Cemetery in Beaver Twp., Noble Co., OH. The dates on the marker were illegible, but it is probably James Sebastian DeLong's first wife. James and his second wife are buried elsewhere in the same cemetery.
